Northwestern Mutual celebrates volunteer work with \$15,000 grant to Chris and Kelly's HOPE Foundation Northwestern Mutual, through its Foundation, will present Chris and Kelly's HOPE Foundation with a \$15,000 grant on behalf of Steve Grant, a recipient of the company's Community Service Awards.

The annual program honors the company's financial professionals for extraordinary volunteer work. Grant created Chris and Kelly's HOPE Foundation in 2012, after the loss of his two sons to accidental overdoses. The organization works to financially assist other programs and organizations that strive to help adolescents and young adults struggling with substance abuse, addiction and depression. Steve dedicates his time to raising awareness of the organization and its cause through his story, in addition to leading numerous fundraising efforts.

Clemson University head coach Dabo Swinney and Northwestern Mutual – Greenville managing director John Tripoli will recognize Grant for his award at The Family Effect's 2017 Transformation Breakfast on May 23 from 8 to 9 a.m. at the TD Convention Center, 1 Exposition Drive, Greenville. During this presentation, Grant will share his personal story, and present a \$15,000 grant to Chris & Kelly's HOPE Foundation as part of his award.

Chris and Kelly's HOPE Foundation has provided financial support to The Family Effect, an organization that works to reduce addiction as a leading cause of family collapse, over the past several years. Grant also serves as vice chair on The Family Effect's board of directors.
